PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Week 3– America the beautiful! Celebrating and learning about the United States of America will be the focus of this patriotic theme. Together, we will make a flag from a pallet to display on our Children's House playground. Wave your flags and march along.

Week 4 – Say YES to the mess! This is the quintessential arts and crafts camp - a literal hodgepodge of activities and mediums that include crayons, pottery, cloth, clay, and duct tape... the sky is the limit. We'll use all the good crafty verbs guaranteed to inspire: blending, molding, sculpting, pasting, painting... fun! Neat nicks need not apply!

Week 8 – Community Helpers! We'll explore and meet various helpers in our community...people that choose a life of service to their communities.
