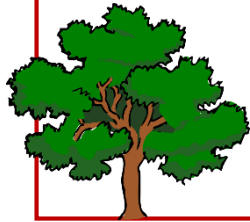


## A Summer to Cherish

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

**Week 1 – “Construction and Community Helpers Zone!”** All the kids will want to dig in! Students will explore construction and community helper vehicles both indoors and outdoors! Fire trucks, police cars, and road commission vehicles...oh, my!

**Week 2 – “Rainforest Adventure”** Let's go exploring! We'll learn about the plants, layers, and animals of the rainforest, create our own rainforest, and perhaps meet a few special visitors from the rainforest!

**Week 3 – “Silly Sports” (no camp on 7/4 & 7/5)** Let the games begin! It's all about teamwork. Join us as we play an expansive array of fun outdoor games throughout the week! Don't miss this silly and active week!

**Week 4 – “Out of This World”** We'll get a little wild and crazy as we conduct experiments and explore the universe. Can we defy gravity? Campers will learn about planets and space travel. Your child will design and build a rocket ship they want to take to the moon! Don't space out and miss this far out adventure.

**Week 5 – “Lego® Week”** Do you have a Lego lover in your home? Do you have a child ready to explore the world of Lego's for the first time? Let's create with hands on experiences! What will your child create? Building and learning challenges each individual through creative play in a fun, relaxed and stimulating environment!

**Week 6 – “Ocean and Seashore”** Ready to make some waves? This camp is focused on the ocean and everything that swims, floats, or lives nearby.
